On Site Lodging

We will be using Wright Hall at the splendid Menucha Retreat Center (view pictures at <http://menucha.org/>) in the Columbia Gorge. Camp-style, multiple occupancy, same-sex rooms plus food cost \$115/night. (No single or couples accommodations available). Towel and linens provided. Regular conference runs Friday dinner to Sunday lunch. A pre-conference day is available starting with Thursday dinner and includes Friday breakfast and lunch. Special needs diets (including vegetarian meals) can be accommodated at a fee of +\$6/meal-day and must be requested by August 20th to guarantee availability. Meal day 1: Thursday Dinner, Friday Breakfast, Friday Lunch. Meal day 2: Fri Dinner, Saturday Breakfast, Saturday Lunch. Meal day 3: Saturday Dinner, Sunday Breakfast & Lunch.

Commuter Options

Commuter rates are \$60 per calendar-day for Thursday and for Friday, \$75 for Saturday, and \$50 for Sunday and does not include all meals. Commuter meals included are Thursday night for the pre-conference. Commuter meals for the conference are: Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch. Extra meals can be purchased for \$10. Please note special needs (including vegetarian meals) cost \$2 additional per meal and must be requested by August 20th to ensure accommodation.
